AIR TRAVEL TO CAMP FROM MIAMI

DATE OF DEPARTURE - SATURDAY MORNING, JUNE 26

TIME TO MEET: 8:30 AM AT AMERICAN AIRLINES TICKET COUNTER

Flight #2060 is scheduled to depart at 10:10 AM. It is important that you be on time.
Arrival in Boston (Logan) - 1:25 pm.

PROCEDURE: You must report to the Robindel escort, Nina Yurman, near the AMERICAN ticket counter before you do anything else. We expect her to have the boarding passes. Where possible, we expect the "big" camp sister to arrange to sit with or near her "little" camp sister as assigned.

From Boston the girls will be escorted directly to camp and a snack will be provided.

DRESS - All campers are required to wear blue Robindel shirts with blue shorts or jeans.

All campers and their families should remain in the immediate ticket counter area. When all the children have been checked in or at about 9:00 AM, Nina will take the Robindel group through security to the gate. At this time, parents must say good-bye to their daughter as no one without a boarding pass will be allowed to proceed through security to the gate area.

BAGGAGE & CARRY-ON RESTRICTIONS: With all the complications of air travel, we do not want any baggage checked in. Bring one small carry-on.

PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE. We plan to escort the children through security approximately 60 minutes prior to departure. If you arrive after the group has left the ticket counter area to proceed through security, CHECK WITH THE AIRLINE SUPERVISOR AS TO HOW TO PROCEED.

BRING NO PEANUT OR NUT PRODUCTS. NO CELL PHONES PLEASE.
