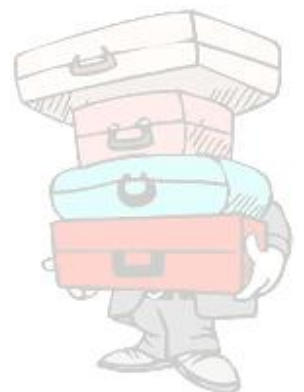


# STAFF PACKING LIST/DRESS CODE

## ***BEFORE YOU START PACKING, READ THE NOTES BELOW!***

- LIMITED SPACE: You will have only one cubby (size 2 ft. x 2 ft. x 2 1/2 ft. ht. with 3 shelves) and limited hanging space.
- TIME OFF: You might like to bring some clothes for evenings/days off. The area is very casual.
- Please PUT YOUR NAME IN ALL ITEMS including non-clothing items.
- LAUNDARY - Camp Laundry is sent out and (no ironing, everything put in dryers) done individually once each week, clothing returned within 24 hours separately packaged (\$7 cost per week).  
Staff laundry in camp contains 3 washers & dryers for your use at no cost to you. You can also go to local Laundromats. It is advised to buy laundry supplies when you get out to camp! It's a pain (and HEAVY) to haul that in your suitcase. There is a Wal-Mart and such stores nearby and you will have opportunities to pick up things you need/forgot once you're out there.
- US/CANADIAN STAFF – Please bring pillow, 2 blankets & 3 towels. Sheets and pillowcases are provided by camp & one towel is laundered each day.
- OVERSEAS STAFF – ALL blankets, pillow, towels, sheets and pillowcases are provided by camp.



# REQUIRED CLOTHING

The following sections will help to clear up questions you may have about staff attire. We require all CAMPERS and STAFF to wear navy & white clothing in an effort to prevent clothing competition.

## **Q) Why does the staff have to wear Navy and White?**

We ask you to adhere to the correct attire to set the right example for campers. At the same time, it helps to create an air of professionalism at camp.

## **Q) What types of T-Shirts are acceptable?**

T-shirts must be solid white or solid navy (not royal or other blues) with no sayings, photographs or colored trim. A small logo over the heart is acceptable. Staff sweatshirts & t-shirts say "Camp Robindel--Staff."

## **Q) What types of shorts are acceptable?**

Khaki shorts are acceptable. Neat jean shorts are permitted. Gym shorts with a light or dark stripe are acceptable. NO CANDY STRIPED OR BOXER SHORTS ARE PERMITTED outside of the cabin.

## **Q) Does my Department have any Specific Clothing?**

Check our Department Specific Section. If it is not listed, then there is NO specific clothing.

**STAFF T-SHIRTS:** You will be required to purchase (at least) 1 white and 1 Navy staff shirts (\$6 each). You are welcome to buy more T-shirts. Returning staff is welcomed to buy new shirts, but it is not required.

· **STAFF SWEATSHIRTS** – these are optional to purchase. Navy crew neck sweatshirts (\$11) and Navy hooded sweatshirts (\$14).

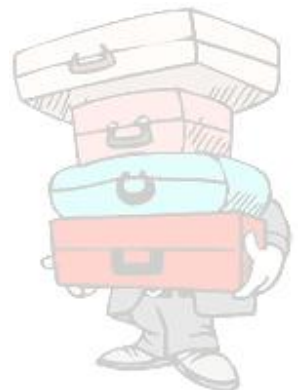
